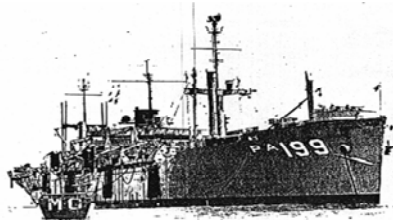

Attend Morehead State University in the Fall of 2004 and earn a Bachelors degree in Business Administration with an option in Computer Information Systems.

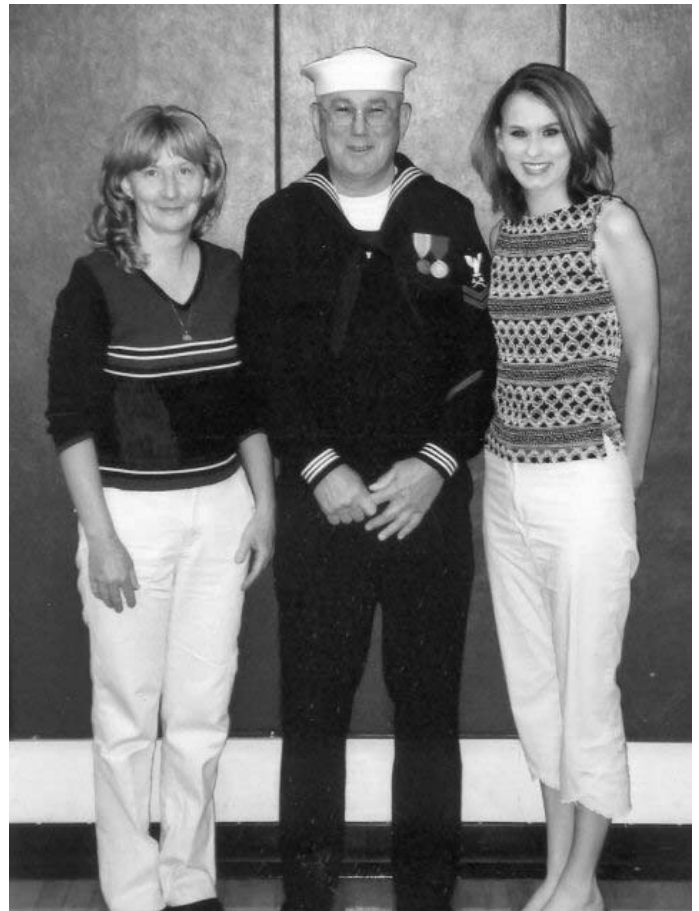
I can't thank the members of the USS Magoffin enough for giving me this scholarship. It will enable me to further my education and to earn my degree in Business Administration.

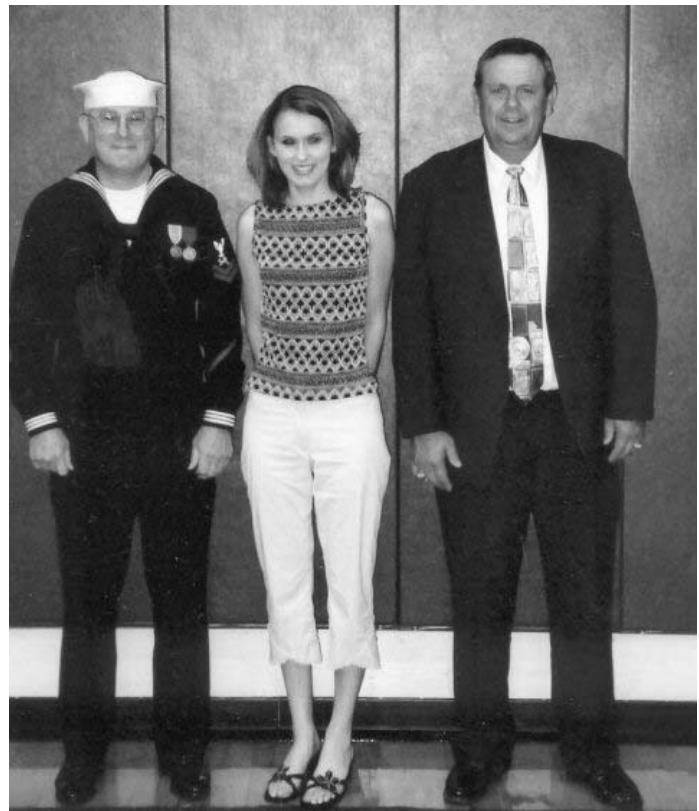

Sandy Spurlock, Tom Haglage, & Debra Spurlock at the May 11th awards ceremony at Magoffin County High School.

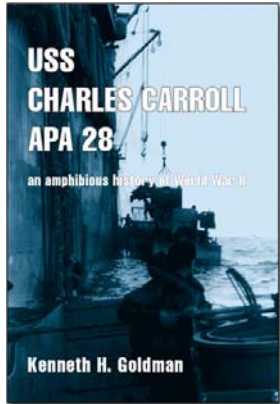

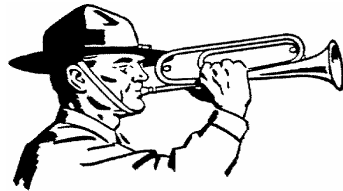

## TAPS

Phillip S. Gronvold, 90, passed away March 16th, 2004, in Pasadena, CA. He was born in Barton, North Dakota, November 24, 1913 to Torger T. Gronvold and Gjertrude Hagen Gronvold. He graduated from Barton High School in Barton, ND in 1935. Phillip married Tessie J. Vorris, May 3, 1947 in Bremerton, WA. Phillip served in the US Navy from 1936 to 1966 achieving rank of CWO-4. After leaving the US Navy, he worked for National Steel & Shipbuilding in San Diego and Helix Water District in La Mesa. The Gronvold family lived in the San Diego area from 1955 to 1979. Phillip is survived by his daughter Rebecca Gronvold Hatch and her husband Mark of South Pasadena, CA; daughter-in-law Amelia Moniz of Isle of Palm, SC; sister Selma Olson of Tempe, AZ; brother Victor Gronvold of Rugby, ND; and grandchildren Jessica, Hillary, and Ross Gronvold and Clare Hatch. Phillip was preceded in death by his wife of 55 years, Tessie in 2002 and his son, Phillip Victor Gronvold in 2001. Phillip served on the *Magoffin* from 1950 to 1954. He was a CWO in the "E" division.
