Registration and Welcome — Hotel Lobby

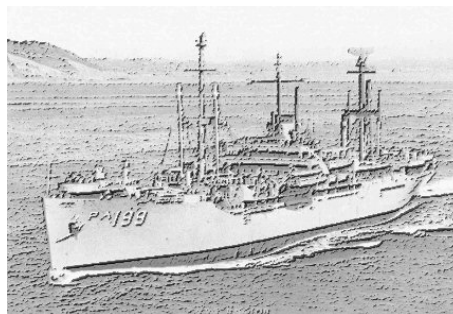
Reunion Banquet 6:00 pm until ????
